

## cSCC Characteristics Associated with Poor Outcomes



Invasion of nerve  
0.1 mm and larger  
increases risk of  
recurrence, lymph  
node and distant  
metastasis, and  
death

Tumor  
diameter is  
directly  
associated with  
higher  
recurrence risk

Tumors on the  
ear, lip, and  
anogenital area

Invasion beyond  
subcutaneous  
fat or 6 mm  
depth

Poor histologic  
differentiation

Desmoplastic  
patterns are 10x  
more likely to recur
