Systemic Lupus International Collaborating Clinics (SLICC) Criteria for SLE

Clinical Criteria

- Acute cutaneous lupus
- Chronic cutaneous lupus
- Nonscarring alopecia
- Oral or nasal ulcers
- Joint disease
- Serositis
- Renal
- Neurologic
- Hemolytic anemia
- Leukopenia or lymphopenia
- Thrombocytopenia

Immunologic Criteria

- ANA
- Anti-dsDNA
- Anti-Sm
- Antiphospholipid antibodies
- Low C3, C4, CH50
- Direct Coomb's test

Diagnosis is based on ≥ 4 of 17 criteria, including

- ≥ 1 clinical and
- ≥1 immunologic criterion

OR

 biopsy-proven lupus nephritis and positive ANA or anti-dsDNA
